RING FOR TIMES ON FRIDAY EVENING AFTER 6pm or times will be displayed on Secretary's caravan on Saturday morning from 10.00am.

Course will be available for walking from 10.00am on Saturday of competition weekend.

A £10 deposit is required for collection of bibs and will be refunded on return of bib.

Please return your bib as soon as you have completed your class as it will be required for later.
