**START TIME 10:00**

1. **X-Poles/50cm Beginners** (Lead-Reins allowed)  
\*Horse/Rider combinations entered in this class are only eligible to enter classes 1 & 2
2. **60-65cm Open** (Lead-Reins allowed)  
\*Horse/Rider combinations entered in this class are only eligible to enter classes 1 & 2 or 2 & 3
3. **70cm OPEN**  
For horses & ponies, ridden by seniors or juniors.
4. **80cm OPEN (Class to start not before 13:00)**  
For horses & ponies, ridden by seniors or juniors.
5. **90cm OPEN**  
For horses & ponies, ridden by seniors or juniors.
6. **1:00m Open**  
For horses & ponies, ridden by seniors or juniors.

Entry Fee £13 including first aid.

Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Place

Prizes: In kind subject to number of entries

Classes will all be run as a Single Phase competition unless otherwise stated.

**N.B. Single Phase Rule: means that competitors jump the first set of fences, e.g. Fences 1 - 7 continuing on to the second phase of the course which is against the clock, e.g. fences 8 -14. The course is jumped consecutively, the competitor remains in the ring and does the jump- off course immediately.**

**NB:** Everybody mounted must wear protective headgear that includes a permanently fitted, non-detachable retaining harness that must be securely fastened. Hats must conform to the new standards; EN1384 (kite marked) or PAS015. Body Protectors, also to current safety standard, are advisable.

Riders must be in light coloured breeches, and riding jackets.

No rider may carry, use or permit to be used a whip greater than 75cm or less than 45cm in length overall nor one that is weighted or with a hard point at the end in the arena, the collecting ring or anywhere in the immediate vicinity of the showground. No substitute for a whip may be carried in. A whip, if carried, should be carried at all times in the hand.

Excessive use of the whip may result in disqualification; this is up to the discretion of the judge.
